The best-connected new strategic employment site on the South Coast




blocwork (Eastleigh) LLP and Southampton International Airport Limited (SIAL) are bringing forward plans for a new strategic employment destination within Solent Freeport.

Navigator Quarter is a designated tax site within the Freeport. It will meet the needs of modern business and create significant economic opportunity for the region, including through the creation of up to 3,000 new jobs.

Our proposals would transform 110 acres of land adjacent to Southampton Airport into a vibrant location for local, national and international businesses to invest in and call their home.

We are bringing forward a planning application to provide up to 92,000 sq m of high-quality employment space on the site, with associated infrastructure works and a new access road.

Before we submit a planning application, we're holding a public consultation on the proposals.

Connected by rail, road and air

Navigator Quarter benefits from **excellent transport links**. It has direct access to **Southampton Airport**, is close to **strategic road networks** (J5 M27 and the M3) and **Southampton Airport Parkway railway station** with a direct route to London Waterloo and other parts of the South Coast.

We will create a new vehicular access into the site, north of the airport runway, and will encourage active travel in and around the site, including cycle paths and green infrastructure. A full Transport Assessment will be submitted as part of our application.

Economic benefits

Navigator Quarter will be a new strategic employment destination, attracting new businesses to the region and delivering a range of economic benefits. The scheme is anticipated to provide **up to 3,000 new jobs** (direct, indirect and during construction) as well as various skills and training opportunities.

The development will be designed to be flexible to suit a broad range of occupiers and sectors, driving new employers to the region and boosting inward investment.


Planning policy

The Navigator Quarter site is allocated for employment development in Eastleigh Borough Council's Local Plan. It's where the Council wants to see new jobs created to support the balanced growth of Eastleigh and the local area.

We are preparing a planning application, which is informed by the Council's policy for the site as well as what we think is achievable here in terms of a high-quality new strategic employment development.
